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Order no. 03 dated 04.06.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Dipankar Biswas, and (2) Sujan Biswas who apprehend arrest in connection with Nadanghat P.S. Case No. 128 of 2026 dated 22.03.2026 U/Ss 85/108/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced. I.O. of the case is also present.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners, the I.O. and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that as per F.I.R. the petitioner no.1/husband since few months after marriage has been staying abroad for his job. Petitioner no.2 is the brother in law. Victim committed suicide out of depression as she was not willing to live with her mother in law and brother in law. It is submitted further that the incident took place on 14.09.2025 and the petition of complaint was present before the Ld. A.C.J.M. Kalna long thereafter on 12.12.2025. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises objection against the prayer of the petitioners and submits that there are sufficient incriminating materials in the C.D. in respect of the offence alleged.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged in the petition of complaint that since after marriage accused persons including the petitioners subjected the complainant's daughter to physical and mental torture on demand of further dowry. On 14.09.2025 being instigated by the in laws, she committed suicide by hanging herself.

On perusal of the materials available, it appears that admittedly petitioner no.1/husband used to stay abroad. The I.O. has collected the copy of the statement of the F.I.R-maker made before the Ld. Magistrate. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and type of allegation made in the statement before the Ld. Magistrate, their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further condition that the petitioners shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.
