The record is taken up for passing order.

Perused the petition under section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and other materials on record and also taken into account the submission made by Ld. Advocates of the parties. It appears that the instant Mat Suit has been filed by petitioner No 1 Surajit Sarkar Sarkar and petitioner No 2 Goutami Sarkar under section 13B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for decree of dissolution of marriage solemnized on 04.02.2015 by way of divorce on mutual consent. Instant Mat Suit was filed by the parties on 24.04.2025

The fact of the case as narrated in the joint application for mutual divorce in a nutshell is that the parties to the proceeding got married on 04.02.2015 as per Hindu rites and customs and the marriage was subsequently registered before Marriage Officer Indranil Palit dt.18/10/2016 being certificate Sl. no.73/2016 Hindu Marriage Register page no.542. After marriage, the petitioner No.2 went to the house of petitioner No 1 and resided as husband and wife in the house of petitioner no.1. Due to difference of taste, temperament and culture differences cropped up between the parties and they could not adjust between themselves and with the efflux of time the differences became so aggravated that the petitioners began to feel that it would be next to impossible to live together as husband and wife and ultimately they started to live separately since 12.10.2022 at their respective paternal house. Since the day of their separation several attempts were made to resolve the dispute and discord between the parties but no fruitful result had been yielded. To avoid further litigation between the parties both parties have decided to get their marriage dissolved by filing the joint application.

Petitioner no.1 was examined as PW1 and petitioner no.2 was examined as P.W.2.

On behalf of petitioner no.1 his Aadhar card had been filed, which was marked as Exhibit – 1 and certificate of marriage was marked as Ext.2.

On behalf of petitioner no.-2, her Aadhar Card was marked as Exhibit – 3.

Present case was filed on 24-04-2025. Record shows that six months have already been elapsed from the date of filing of the application under section 13B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and period of 18 months yet to go. Moreover the parties have been living separately for a period of more than one year from the date of filing of the case and they have not been able to live together for which they have mutually agreed to dissolve their marriage. It is established through their respective unchallenged testimony on oath that their consent is free, voluntary, not obtained by exercising undue influence, fraud and coercion. As such prayer of the petitioners need be allowed.

Court Fees paid is correct.

Hence it is,

ORDERED

that the instant Mat. Suit filed under Section 13B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 be and the same is decreed on mutual consent.

The marriage solemnized between petitioner No.1. Surajit Sarkar and petitioner No. 2 Goutami Sarkar on 04.02.2015 under 13B of Hindu Marriage Act 1955 is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce on mutual consent. The order shall take effect immediately.

The Marriage Certificate bearing certificate SL.No.73/2016 dt.03.10.2016, Hindu Marriage Register Page No.542 registering marriage of petitioner no. 1 Surajit Sarkar and petitioner No. 2 Goutami Sarkar on 18.10.2016, before Indranil Palit, Marriage Officer, stands cancelled from this day.
