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Order no. 02 dated 06.06.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioner namely Sanjit Biswas who apprehend arrest in connection with Ausgram P.S. Case No. 198 of 2026 dated 16.05.2026 U/Ss 353(1)/356(3)/308(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that since after publication of the result of assembly election, 2026 this petitioner has been running from pillar to post to save his life. He was compelled to leave his house. He has written letters to different authorities but without any result. He has been falsely implicated in this case. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of this petitioner has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that there are sufficient incriminating materials in the C.D. against the present petitioner in respect of the offences alleged.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged that this petitioner with co- accused persons were engaged in affixing posters with defamatory contents of the Chief Minister. They also extorted money since 2021 by putting several persons under fear of death.

On perusal of the materials in the C.D. it appears that I.O. of the case has collected the statement of the victim of the alleged offence of extortion. Considering the nature and seriousness of the offence alleged and supporting materials in the C.D., prayer of the petitioner U/S 482 B.N.S.S. is rejected.

Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.

Instant Criminal Misc.- Case is thus disposed of.
