This petition coming on this day before me in the presence of M/s.K.Vignesh, Counsel for petitioner, and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for prosecution and upon hearing the arguments on both sides this court passed the following :-

ORDER

This petition for bail u/s.480 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner/accused, was remanded to judicial custody on 03.10.2024 in Crime No.253/2024 on the file of the respondent/police for the alleged offences under section 79 BNS r/w Sec.4 of TNPHW Act 2022 & 66(D), 67A IT Act 2008.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the

petitioner is innocent and the he has been falsely implicated in this case by the respondent/police and that the petitioner is ready to co-operate with the investigation and also undertakes to appear before this court regularly without fail during the trial and that he would also ready to comply the condition imposed by this court without any deviation, hence seeks to release the petitioner on bail.

3. Per contra the learned APP strongly objected to release the accused for the reasons investigation is still in process and if the accused released on bail there is every chance for tampering the witnesses, and the nature of offences are very serious in nature, and if released there is every possibilities to abscond, and it will affect the investigation, hence, strongly objected to grant bail.

4. Heard both sides. Perused records. The case of the prosecution is that the accused created and using the fake instagram account he uploaded the morphed photos of the victim girl with obscene comments, which resulted the outrage of the modesty of the victim girl, who is the ex-lover of the petitioner, based on the complaint the accused was secured and remanded to judicial custody on 03.10.2024.

5. Considering the grave nature of offence, and it is against the women and society, initial stage of investigation, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage. Accordingly this petition deserves no merits, petition dismissed.
