		03.10.2018 Bail petition vide the aforesaid Misc. Criminal Application filed on behalf of accused petitioner namely Palak Kumari @ Para, who is in judicial custody since 24.09.2018 in connection with AHTU P.S. Case No. 03/2018 GR No. 988/2018, is put up for hearing. Learned defence counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and she has been falsely implicated in this case. That the fact of dispute stated by the informant against the petitioner is of civil nature and does not constitute any criminal offence at all. That the allegation made in the FIR is false and concocted and she is nowhere involved in the present offence. That the petitioner has no criminal antecedent and she is in custody since 24.09.2018 and it is prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The learned APP vehemently opposed the prayer. Heard both sides and perused the case record. From its perusal it transpires that the FIR is instituted u/s 370/374/34 of IPC and Section 16 of Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act. It is alleged that this accused petitioner used to come to the house of informant and persuaded the informant to come with her to Delhi to earn. The informant and her mother and family members were reluctant to such proposal but in the month of July when the parents of the informant were not in the house, the accused petitioner came to her house and paid Rs. 1000/- to her brother and took her to Delhi

Contd..../2 03.10.2018		where she with the help of her brother Jitendra Kumar engaged her in the house of one Rampal where she has to do all household work. The said landlord and landladies did not provide sufficient food to her and tortured her in various manner. Investigation is going on. Petitioner accused is named in the FIR and there is direct allegation of committing this serious offence and the victim has also corroborated her fardbayan in her statement u/s 164 Cr.P.C. Considering the above facts and seriousness of the offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the bail petition filed on behalf of petitioner is hereby rejected and Misc. Criminal Applications are disposed off.
