Record is put up on the prayer of the accused 1. Rajkumar Mete and 2. Mintu Mete, who surrender before this Court today. They are taken into custody and remanded to J/C till 22.04.2025.

W/As issued on 01.03.2024 are recalled.

At this stage, one bail petition along with a Vokatnama for the accused persons is filed. Heard both sides.

It is submitted that earlier both the accused persons were on bail and that due to miscommunication after commitment of the case they failed to appear before this Court on the very first date.

No objection is raised by the Learned P.P.

Considering the fact that earlier the accused persons were on bail, the prayer for bail is considered and allowed.

The accused 1. Rajkumar Mete and 2. Mintu Mete may find interim bail till 22.04.2025 of Rs.3,000/- each with two sureties of like amount i.e. Rs.1,500/- each, with a direction that they must be present before the Court on each date fixed.

Bail bond should be accepted subject to the satisfaction of the Learned C.J.M., Purba Bardhaman.

A copy of this order be sent to the Learned C.J.M., Purba Bardhaman, for information.

This case is otherwise ready for disposal.

The case is transferred to the 4th Court of Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Burdwan.

To date **(22.04.2025)** for appearance of the accused persons if on bail on furnishing required bail bonds i/d for their production before the transferee Court.

Record be sent to that Court by the next date positively.
