Subrata Mondal vs. Supriya Mondal

Order No.25 dated 22.09.2025 :

Both sides file hajira.

Minor Sayani Mondal is produced today by the opposite party/mother.

Heard the minor personally in my chamber.

The application of the petitioner/father dated 11.09.2025 is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

It is the serious allegation of the petitioner/father that the opposite party/mother is wilfully disobeyed the visitation order dated 02.06.2025.

On 02.06.2025, on consent of both parties, an order of visitation was passed as follows,-

“On such consent and compromise, the application under Section 12 of the Act is allowed whereby the order of visitation is passed to the effect that the minor Sayani Mondal be produced before this Courtroom on each 1st and 3rd Saturday at 2 p.m. and the petitioner/father is allowed to meet with the minor daughter up to 5 p.m., until further order. However, both parties are directed not to inflict any kind of pressure, pain, trouble or anxiety in the mind of the minor during this visit time.

Opposite party/mother is directed to produce the minor before this Courtroom accordingly and the petitioner/father shall bear the cost of production of the minor from the house of the opposite party and to take back the minor by the opposite party there, day to day in hand.”

The minor is now willing to visit with her father.

In the circumstances, for the ensuing Puja Vacation, an interim visitation order is passed in the following form whereby **Learned Advocate Smt. Dipali Priyanvada, having her chamber at Burdwan Housing, G +4D (4th Floor), G.T. Road East, Muchipara, beside the Muchipara Petrol Pump, Burdwan (Contact No.8637599813)**, is appointed as the Special Officer.

The petitioner/father is permitted to visit his minor daughter Sayani Mondal at the chamber of the said Special Officer Smt. Dipali Priyanvada, on 12.10.2025, 19.10.2025, 26.10.2025, and on 02.11.2025, from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The Special Officer, appointed for the purpose, will allow only the person whose favour this visitation order is passed to remain present in this chamber during such visitation, and she is directed to maintain one attendance register in this regard.

The petitioner/father shall bear the fees of Rs.600/- (Rupees six hundred) for per visitation, payable to the Special Officer in cash hand to hand for which, the Special Officer will issue receipt.

The opposite party is directed to produce the minor at the chamber of the Special Officer on the dates and at the time as stated above, accordingly.

The petitioner/father is to bear the cost of journey for bringing the minor from the house of the opposite party to the Chamber of the Special Officer and returning to the house of the opposite party on each date of visitation, hand to hand to the opposite party.

To 19-11-2025 for further order.
