Fresh petition u/s 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 alongwith application under section 9 of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act r/w section 151 CPC received today by way of e-filing. It be checked and registered, as per rules.

This is a petition u/s 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 filed by the petitioner. Alongwith the petition, an application has also been moved under the same provision praying for *exparte-interim* order.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted that now, the respondent is in default of more than 7 installments and in case the vehicle in question is not taken into possession by the Receiver, to be appointed by this court, the petitioner would suffer irreparable loss. A request has been made to pass an *exparte-interim* order.

Arguments heard on the said application.

Vide my separate order announced in the open court today, the application is disposed of whereby Mr. Ganga Ram Barjujar, Representative/employee of the petitioner has been

appointed as the receiver to take possession of the vehicle in question.
