Order no. 03 dated 04.06.2026:

The application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely (1) Bapi Mallick @ Abul Kalam Mallick, (2) Matal Seikh @ Habibullah Seikh, (3) Raju Seikh @ Sekh Ahammad Ali, (4) Rupchand Molla, (5) Rahamat Kazi, (6) Madhu Molla @ Abbasuddin Molla, (7) Imran Molla @ Imran Rahaman Molla, (8) Rahamat Sekh, (9) Saddam Sekh @ Nur Ali Sekh, (10) Sk. Tariqul Islam, (11) Sohin Sekh @ Atabul Sekh, and (12) Nayan Sekh who apprehend arrest in connection with Mangalkote P.S. Case No. 137 of 2026 dated 02.05.2026 U/Ss 126(2)/117(2)/118(2)/324(4)/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Record of G.R. Case received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners, and Ld. P.P. In-charge.

By showing some documents, it is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that petitioner no.1 lodged one F.I.R. on 30.04.2026 as they were assaulted by the complainant party. As a counter blast instant F.I.R. was lodged on 02.05.2026. These petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. It is the further submission of the Ld. Advocate that no such application of these petitioners has either been moved before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court or by this Court on any earlier occasion. Hence, Ld. Advocate prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners on any condition as this Court deems fit.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raises no objection and submits that no serious injury was sustained by the injured.

Perused the materials on record and in the C.D.

It is alleged in the written complaint that on 29.04.2026 when one polling agent Bistu Das left the polling booth to have lunch, accused persons assaulted him mercilessly and left him with broken hands and head injury.

On perusal of the C.D. it appears that the I.O. has collected the medical documents of said Bistu Das and Sudhakar Majhi. Doctor observed that Bistu Das has no external injury. There was swelling over scalp, pain and swelling over right hand and pain in left shoulder joint. Doctor noted pain and swelling over middle portion of right leg, pain over lower back left side aspect and pain in the middle finger. No external injury was found on the person of Sudhakar Majhi. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and nature of injury, their prayer u/s 482 B.N.S.S. is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the above named accused petitioners in connection with the above noted case, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs. 3,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer, on the conditions stipulated in section 482(2) of B.N.S.S. with further directions that the petitioners shall meet with the I.O. of the case once in a week till completion of investigation by the I.O.

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Let a copy of this order along with the record of G.R. Case be transmitted to the concerned Court for information and necessary action.

C.D. be returned.
