Present Misc. case is arising out of an application u/s 482 of BNSS in connection with Monteswar P.S. Case No. 220 of 2026 dated 16.05.2026 u/s. 137(2)/140(3)/3(5) BNS & S.6 of POCSO Act with a prayer for granting bail to the petitioner.

Today is fixed for hearing of bail petition of petitioners Kayem Mondal @ Jhantu Mondal and Chumki Mondal @ Nurnesa Begum.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners at the time of hearing submitted that in the present case there is allegation in the FIR that the victim went missing after leaving the house for attending private tuition. He further submits that the present petitioners are the parents of the principal accused named in the FIR and it is not expected that they would instruct their son to kidnap the victim. Moreover there was no prayer for PC in respect of the principal accused and therefore, there would not be any requirement for custodial interrogation of the petitioners and inview thereof prayer for anticipatory bail may be allowed. He further submits that no prayer for bail of this petitioner is either pending before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court.

Ld. PP in charge, submitted that in the present case there is allegation that the present petitioners assisted principal accused and necessary order may be passed after perusal of the CD.

Considered the submission of both sides.

Present case was instituted by

after perusal of the statement of the victim it does not appear that there is any necessity of detaining the present petitioners in custody. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on furnishing bond of Rs.5000/-each with one surety of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.
