ORDER :

- 1) Perusal of the file shows that the DH has filed the certified copy of order/decreed dt. 14.11.2024 alongwith the list of property of the JD. As per the said list, property of JD are situated within the jurisdiction of Sub-Division Payal, District Ludhiana.
- 2) Order XXI Rule 5 CPC provides that when a decree is to be sent for execution to other Court then the said decree has to be sent directly to such other Court. The said rule has been substituted by Section 72 of the Code of Civil Procedure Amendment Act 1976 w.e.f. 01.02.2007 and the objects and reasons for the said clause provides that routing the transfer of decrees through the District Courts adds to the delay in execution of decrees. Accordingly, the rule was substituted to provide for transfer of decrees directly to other courts.
- 3) In view of the above said statutory provision, the present decree is sent to the Court of Ld. District & Sessions Judge,

Ludhiana for entrusting it to the competent Court in this regard for 30.07.2026. Ahlmad is directed to prepare certificate of non satisfaction of decree on a separate sheet of paper. Thereafter, alongwith the execution file, copy of the order, copy of decree and the non-satisfaction certificate be sent to the transferee Court on proforma no. 3, 4 and 5 as well then before the date fixed.
