ORDER:-

1. Present bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in case FIR no. 117 dated 8.7.2026 under Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act, P.S Divn no.4, Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of the applicant/accused.
2. Upon notice, Additional Public Prosecutor appeared on behalf of State.
3. As per the police report on the basis of secret information on 8.7.2026 applicant/accused was apprehended alongwith 124 bottles of liquor marka Empie No.1 Mota Santra for sale in Chandigarh only without any legal and valid license.
4. I have heard the Ld. counsel for the applicant /accused and Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the record.
5. Accused is in judicial custody since 8.7.2026. He is no more required for the custodial investigation. Presentation of challan and conclusion of the trial shall take considerable time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody any more and rather he will be a burden on the state exchequer.

6. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case. Without commenting anything on merits of the case, this court is of the considered view that the bail is the rule of law and jail is an exception to the same. Therefore, the applicant/accused is no more required for custodial investigation of the case, the applicant/accused is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing the bail/ surety bonds to the tune of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate subject to following conditions:-

- 1). That the applicant/accused will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of case so as to dissuade his/her from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.
- 2). That the applicant/ accused will not leave the territory of India without prior permission of the court.
