Today is fixed for reconciliation / hearing.

Both parties are present with their respective Ld. Lawyers.

Reconciliation failed. The instant Matrimonial suit is taken up for hearing.

Respective affidavit evidence are tendered.

The parties got married on **27.04.1992** as per Hindu Rites and Custom and led conjugal life at **Dhokrasahid (Nichumath), P.S-Burdwan, District-Purba Bardhaman. In the said wedlock they have a daughter namely Mou Das, aged about 29 years, who is presently married and one son who is aged about 25 years. The said son stays with her mother.** A few days after the said marriage disputes cropped up between the parties. Despite all sincere efforts by themselves and their well-wishers, the petitioners failed to resume their conjugal life and they are living separately till date. They started living separately on and from **20.03.2024**. There is no chance of resuming of conjugal life between the parties. The parties ultimately agreed to dissolve their marriage by divorce. The instant application **u/s 13 B of the Hindu Marriage Act** was presented before this court on **23.04.2025**. the petition was not withdrawn within the cooling off period of six months.

In their respective affidavit evidence the petitioners have reiterated that they got married, lived together as husband and wife. **A daughter and a son were born** but due to disputes and differences they started living separately. The petitioners failed to resolve their dispute and resume conjugal life.

The marriage took place and the petitioners lived together and the **petitioner / wife live all within the jurisdiction of this court**. At this stage, no collusion is forthcoming. It seems the parties have voluntarily made the application on mutual consent. It is not procured by exercising coercion, misrepresentation or fraud. The parties have been living separately for more than **02** years. So there is no bar to grant the relief as prayed for.

The application for divorce is properly stamped.

Hence,

It is ordered,

that the instant Matrimonial Suit be and the same is allowed on mutual consent **u/s 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act**.

It is hereby declared that marriage between the parties solemnized on **27.04.1992** is hereby dissolved with effect from the date of this order.

Let a copy of the decree be supplied to the parties free of cost as and when the decree will be drawn up.

The parties have produced their identity proof namely **Aadhar card**. The original documents are tallied with the photocopy and returned to the parties.
