Today, the case is fixed for appearance of the accused person and evidence.

Sole accused, namely, Naser Ali Molla, is absent by filing a petition u/s 317 of CrPC, praying for his representation through his Ld Lawyer.

One witness, namely, Chandan Kumar Banerjee, a retired police personnel, has turned up today.

It appears from the record that warrant of arrest is pending against the witness. Ld. PP-in-Charge files a petition, praying for granting bail to the witness on the grounds stated therein.

On prayer of Ld PP-in-Charge, issue summons upon the complainant, being CSW No. 1, fixing 06.12.2024 for evidence as a last chance.

Prosecution is directed to issue summons and production of Alamat on the date fixed.
