

ORDER BELOW EXH.- 1

The complainant has submitted the withdraw pursis vide **Ex.66**. In view of the provision of Sec.257 of Cr. P.C., If a complainant, at any time before a final order is passed in any case under this Chapter, satisfies the Magistrate that there are sufficient grounds for permitting him to withdraw his complaint against the accused, or if there be more than one accused, against all or any of them, the Magistrate may permit him to withdraw the same, and shall thereupon acquit the accused against whom the complaint is so withdrawn. In view of the pursis vide **Ex.66**, the complainant does not want to proceed with the matter and wants to withdraw the same, thus, it appears just and proper to permit the complainant to withdraw the present complaint and accordingly permitted. Thus, this complaint is hereby disposed off as withdrawn by compromise and the accused is hereby acquitted from the prosecution of Sec.138 of N.I. Act U/s.257 of Cr.P.C.
