Today is fixed physical production of accused persons and consideration of charge.

All the four (4) accused persons (i) Prahlad @ Bhakta Ruidas, (ii) Bubul Ruidas, (iii) Ashim Ruidas and (iv) Biswajit @ Rai Saha are physically produced from J.C., placed on dock and they are further remanded to J.C. till 20.05.2026.

Learned advocates representing the accused persons is present.

Learned PP in-charge is also present along with the Case Diary.

Now the case record is taken up for consideration of charge.

Perused the case diary.

It appears from the case record that there are prima facie sufficient materials in the case record and CD to frame charge under Section 103(1)/238/61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 against all the four (4) accused persons namely (i) Prahlad @ Bhakta Ruidas, (ii) Bubul Ruidas, (iii) Ashim Ruidas and (iv) Biswajit @ Rai Saha.

Accordingly, charge is framed against all the four (4) accused persons namely (i) Prahlad @ Bhakta Ruidas, (ii) Bubul Ruidas, (iii) Ashim Ruidas and (iv) Biswajit @ Rai Saha for committing an offence punishable under Sections 103(1)/238/61(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023.

The substances of acquisition is read over and explained to the accused person persons in Bengali language to which they pleaded not guilty by saying 'ami nirdosh' and claimed to be tried.

The charge Form containing the charge with one head be kept with the record in separate sheet.

Fix 20.05.2026 for examination of CSW-1 (defacto complainant) .

Prosecution is requested to take necessary step to ensure the presence of the witnesses.

At this stage, two separate bail applications are filed, one on behalf of the accused Prahlad @ Bhakta Ruidas, and other for accused (ii) Bubul Ruidas, (iii) Ashim Ruidas and (iv) Biswajit @ Rai Saha praying for bail on the grounds stated therein.

Copy served to the learned PP in-charge.

Heard the learned advocates for the accused/petitioners who have submitted before the Court that these accused persons are local men having permanent hearth and home within the jurisdiction of this court and they have been in custody since 12.11.2025. It has also been submitted that the investigation of this case has been completed and the investigating officer has already submitted charge sheet under section **103(1)/238/61(2) of BNS**. Learned advocates for the accused/petitioners have prayed for bail of the accused persons on any terms and conditions.

Learned PP in-charge has raised strong objection against the said bail prayer by submitting that there are sufficient ingredient against the accused persons. He has also submitted that if the accused petitioners are released on bail, there are every possibility of tampering the evidence.

Perused the bail petitions, case diary and other materials on record.

The case record reflects that this is a case for committing offence punishable u/s **103(1) of BNS** and there is sufficient incriminating material against all the accused persons. Furthermore, the postmortem report is in favour of the prosecution.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find any reason to allow their bail prayer at this stage.

Hence, both the bail petitions stand rejected.
