Record pertaining to acquisition/notification dated 10.07.2008, vide which Award No. 6 dated 30.07.2010 was announced by the Competent Authority, Land Acquisition-cum-DRO, Panchkula, as well as acquisition notification dated 25.01.2007, vide which Award No. 13 dated 02.09.2008 was announced by the said authority, has not been produced.

Sammat Singh, Patwari from DRO Office, Panchkula, is present and has suffered the following statement:

“Stated that I have been deputed by the DRO Office, Panchkula to attend the case proceedings in the Court. I shall produce the attested copy of complete record of acquisition notification dated 10.07.2008 vide which award no. 6 dated 30.07.2010 was announced by Competent Authority Land Acquisition-cum-DRO, Panchkula and acquisition notification dated 25.01.2007 vide which award no. 13 was announced by Competent Authority Land Acquisition-cum-DRO, Panchkula 02.09.2008 alongwith the chart depicting the details of acquired land, shares of land holders, entitlement of land holders as per their share, amount to be disbursed to the land holders, acquisition notification under Section 3A, 3D of National Highway Act, 1956. Further the demand regarding the payment of compensation shall also be made from the National Highway Authority of India, Chandigarh within seven working days from today.”

Reply to the application under Section 151 CPC seeking enlargement of time for depositing the awarded amount in terms of order dated 12.09.2025 has not been filed.

Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner submits that upon demand being raised by the Competent Authority, Land Acquisition-cum-DRO, Panchkula, the National Highways Authority of India, Chandigarh shall deposit the compensation amount within two weeks from the date of such demand.

Heard. The request is allowed.

List on **04.05.2026** for filing reply to the aforesaid application, if any, and for depositing the compensation amount.

The Competent Authority, Land Acquisition-cum-DRO, Panchkula, through Sh. Sammat Singh, Patwari, is directed to produce the complete acquisition record, strictly in terms of the statement made today.

In case of failure to comply with the aforesaid statement, including failure to produce the record or to raise the demand for payment of compensation within the stipulated period, the concerned Competent Authority, Land Acquisition-cum-DRO, Panchkula shall remain personally present before this Court on the next date of hearing to explain the lapse.

Further, in the event of failure to deposit the compensation amount even after demand is raised by the Competent Authority, the Project Manager, National Highways Authority of India, Chandigarh shall remain personally present to explain the reasons for non-compliance.

Copy of this order be also sent to concerned quarters for necessary information and compliance.
