In this Criminal Misc Case u/sec.483 of BNSS the petitioner namely, Sabyasachi Ghosh @ Debu in connection with NTS PS Case No.58/26 dt.29.04.2026 u/s 85/115(2)/80/3(5) of BNS and 3/ 4 D. P. Act has come up with a prayer for grant of bail.

The Learned Advocate for the accused person and the learned PP in-charge are present.

The case is taken up for hearing and passing order.

At the outset, Learned Advocate for the petitioner/accused person submits that neither any application for bail u/s 483 of BNSS has earlier been rejected by the Hon'ble Court and nor is pending for disposal before the Hon'ble Court and an affidavit to this effect is filed.

Ld. Advocate appearing for the accused person submits that the accused person is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that accused person is in J/C since 29.04.2026. He submitted that the accused is a constable in the West Bengal Police. He submitted that on the date of incident the deceased was residing alone in a rented house at Durgapur where as the accused was employed at Barrackpore. He submitted that the investigation of this case has progressed substantially and prayed for taking into consideration the period of detention of the accused person. The Ld. Advocate further submits that the accused person is innocent and as such prayed for grant of bail to the accused person.

Ld. PP In-charge by referring the statement and further statement of the complainant and the father of the deceased recorded u/s 180 BNSS and the statement of these two witnesses recorded u/s 183 BNSS. Prayed for passing necessary order.

Heard both the sides.

Perused the materials on record and the case diary.

From the perusal of the case record, it is transpired that deceased Rakhi Koner was married to the accused on 28.04.2022 and she was found dead under unnatural circumstances on 27.04.2026 within 7 years of her marriage.

Considering, the rival submission of both sides and considering the materials available in the case record and case diary including the statement of the complainant and the father of the deceased recorded u/s 180 BNSS and their further statement recorded u/s 180 BNSS on 21.05.2026 and also considering the statement of the complainant and the father of the deceased recorded u/s 183 BNSS and considering the PM report wherein the cause of death is appearing to be that death was due to the effects of ante-mortem hanging and also considering the period of detention already undergone by the accused person and taking into account the reflection in the CD regarding the progress of the case that it has almost attend finality as stated therein I am of the considered opinion that the further detention of the accused person namely, Sabyasachi Ghosh @ Debu is not required for the sake of investigation and accordingly, the bail prayer of the accused namely, Sabyasachi Ghosh @ Debu is considered and allowed subject to the condition that the accused will co-operate with the investigating officer till the completion of the investigation.

Thus, the petitioner namely, Sabyasachi Ghosh @ Debu may find bail of

Rs.6,000/- with two registered sureties of Rs.3,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of Ld. ACJM, Durgapur subject to the condition that the accused will co-operate with the investigating officer till the completion of the investigation and till the submission of final report.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Ld. ACJM, Durgapur along with record of G.R. no. 691 of 2026 for information.

The Criminal Misc Case being no.24/2026 is, thus, disposed of.
