It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused
Nikhil Behl that applicant is seeking permission to visit abroad i.e.
Dubai from 10.01.2025 to 16.01.2025 for holidays.

No formal objection to the application has been raised by
CBI.

I have heard the arguments and perused the record.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case,
applicant/accused Nikhil Behl is granted permission to visit abroad i.e.
Dubai from 10.01.2025 to 16.01.2025 on following conditions:-

1. That he shall furnish indemnity/security in the form of NSC/FDR/bank Guarantee for a sum of Rs. One Lakh which shall be refunded on his return.
2. That he shall furnish the addresses of his stay abroad, along with telephone/contact number

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prior to the date of his/her departure from India .

3. That he shall not seek extension of his stay abroad on any other ground including medical grounds.

4. That he shall authorize his counsel to receive notice on his behalf during his stay abroad.

5. That he shall properly instruct his counsel for proceeding further in the case during his stay abroad and no adjournment shall be sought by his counsel for lack of instructions from the accused. Also the accused shall not dispute his identity at a later stage or take the plea of any prejudice having been caused to him due to his absence.

6. In case of any of the above conditions is violated, the surety/FDR shall stand forfeited.

7. That applicant/accused Nikhil Behl will inform about his arrival in India within 7 days of his return to Delhi.

This permission shall be subject to other applicable rules and will not be deemed as directions to any other authority, except the permission from the side of the court.

Copy of this order be given dasti to the accused/applicant and Ld. Counsel for accused/applicant, at his request.

Application stands disposed of accordingly.

Issue notice to the IO to file the current status of A-1 company, as available on the website of Ministry of Corporate Affairs, on the next date of hearing.

It is submitted that the inspection of documents in the Malkhana is currently being undertaken by accused no.4, in compliance of the directions dated 20.08.2024.

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It is further contended that a period of approximately two months is needed for the inspection of documents in the Malkhana, on the ground, that the record is voluminous in nature.

A-4 is directed to complete the inspection of the documents as earliest, so that the matter may be proceeded with.

Re-notify for submissions on the aspect of charge/ further proceedings on **04.04.2025**.
