An anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner **Ravi Shankar @ Ravi Shankar Kumar**, who is apprehending his arrest, in connection with Suppi P.S. Case No. 35/2024, registered u/s. 363, 366, 376 of the I.P.C. and u/s 4 of the POCSO Act.

Heard Sri Arimardan Narain Singh, the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel on behalf of informant. The Special P.P. did not argue.

The allegation against petitioner is to kidnap and commit rape upon the victim in the hotel on the pretext of giving training for getting Government job.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no any bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner either before this court or before the Hon'ble High Court, Patna. He is quite innocent having clean antecedent and has not committed any offence. He has been implicated due to dirty village politics. The petitioner is in Army and is also a reputed person in the village. There is land dispute between both family. It is further alleged that the informant has clearly written in her written report that on 27.02.2024 the petitioner took her to Bairgania and for two-three days petitioner wandering with informant, then how was the case registered on 01.03.2024 which is doubtful. The petitioner is working on a government post in the defence department and there is no possibility of absconding, so his bail petition may kindly be allowed.

Perusal of record shows that the petitioner is named in FIR and direct and specific allegation has been made against him. The victim in her statement recorded u/s 164 Cr.P.C. has also supported the prosecution case as alleged and has made direct and specific allegation

against this petitioner. During course of hearing on bail petition the victim along with her mother physically appeared in the court, victim stated that alleged occurrence took place against her but her mother has compromised a case with accused person. The victim is minor as per school certificate. Investigation against the petitioner is going on. The offence alleged by victim and as disclosed in her statement u/s 164 Cr.P.C. is very heinous in nature.

Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner above named be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court within four weeks from the receipt of the order, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned concerned court, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s. 438(2) Cr.P.C.
