Present Misc. case is arising out of an application u/s 482 of BNSS in connection with Kalna P.S. Case No. 355 of 2026 dated 19.05.2026 u/s. 8 of POCSO Act of BNS and 351(2) of BNS with a prayer for granting bail to the petitioner.

Today is fixed for hearing of bail petition of petitioner Baburam Bairagi.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner at the time of hearing submitted that the petition has been falsely implicated out of political rivalry. He further submits that it is not natural for victim to go to her tutor after the alleged incident and although the incident took place in the morning but FIR was lodged in the evening and already statement of the victim has been recorded and no fruitful result can be achieved by detaining the petitioner in custody and therefore he may be enlarged on bail. He further submits that no prayer for bail of this petitioner is either pending before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court.

Ld. PP in charge, opposed the prayer and submitted that the victim clearly stated about the incident and therefore anticipatory bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

Considered the submission of both sides. Perused CD.

The present case victim in her statement before Ld. Magistrate clearly stated that the petitioner called her on the pretext of giving Prasad to her and thereafter committed the offence with her and her cry was heard by one lady who raised alarm and thereafter she was let to go by the petitioner.

Considering the nature of alleged offence and material in CD I am not inclined to entertain the prayer for anticipatory bail and the same stands rejected.
