Today is fixed for passing ex parte order in connection with this suit.

As per materials on record the plaint was filed on 18-03-2025 u/s- 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the petitioner/wife against the OP/ Husband Sanjit Sharma.

Summons of this case was duly served upon the OP and inspite of receiving summons the OP did not appear before the court to contest the suit. Accordingly, as per order dated 21-04-2026 the suit is proceeding ex parte against the OP.

To substantiate the case of the petitioner/ wife examined herself as P.W.-1 and one witness namely Amar Banerjee is examined as PW-2.

As per plaint, the petitioner and the OP got married on 20-09-2015 as per Hindu rites and customs and the marriage ceremony was held at the paternal house of the petitioner. After marriage the petitioner and the OP started to live together as husband and wife at the house of the OP. The marriage was duly consummated and one male child was begotten. After marriage the OP started to inflict torture upon the petitioner over the demand of money. On 02-01-2023 the OP drove the petitioner out from her matrimonial home and since then she was residing at her paternal house, since then the OP did not take any information of the petitioner and her child. So the petitioner filed the petition before this Court on 18-03-2025 u/s- 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

Perused the Written examination in chief and the evidence on dock of the petitioner as PW-1 and the witness as PW-2 and there is nothing to disbelieve the unchallenged testimony of PW-1 and PW-2.

The petitioner preferred to file the present suit after passing of more than one year of their marriage.

The present suit is filed after one year of the date from which the parties are residing separately.

It is also established that the marriage of the parties was held on 20-09-2015 as per Hindu rites and customs.

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: 2 :

The marriage between the parties was solemnized within the jurisdiction of this Court and the parties lastly resided together within the jurisdiction of this Court and so this Court have ample power to try the case.

There is no other issue before this Court to consider that the present suit is filed collusively by the petitioner.

In such circumstances there is nothing to disallow the prayer of the petitioner.

Court fees paid is correct.

Hence, it is,

O R D E R E D

that the Mat. Suit bearing No.126 of 2025 filed u/s- 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the petitioner be and the same is decreed exparte. Accordingly the marriage between the petitioner **Sima Dhali** and OP **Sanjit Sharma** solemnized on 20-09-2015 as per Hindu Marriage rites and customs is hereby dissolved by the decree of divorce exparte.
