Present Misc. case is arising out of an application u/s 483 of BNSS in connection with Nadanghat P.S. Case No. 128 of 2026 dated 22.03.2026 u/s. 85(2)/108/3(5) BNS GR 511 of 2026 with a prayer for granting bail to the petitioner.

Today is fixed for hearing of bail petition of petitioner Mamata Biswas.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner at the time of hearing submitted that in the present case the petitioner is the mother-in-law of the victim and she is in custody since 26.05.26. He further submits that two other accused persons including husband of the victim were granted anticipatory bail by the Ld. Sessions Judge, Purba Bardhaman. It was further contended that the incident took place on 14.09.2025 but FIR was lodged on 12.12.2025 which also shows that the allegations are outcome of an afterthought and considering the fact that the petitioner is a woman, she may be released on bail on any stringent condition. He further submits that no prayer for bail of this petitioner is either pending before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court.

Ld. PP in charge, while opposing the prayer, submitted that husband of the victim was granted bail on the ground that he used to live at Maldives and the victim used to reside with her mother-in-law and there is material in the CD suggesting that the petitioner instigated the victim to commit suicide.

Considered the submission of both sides.

Perused CD and materials on record.

In the present case there is allegation in the FIR that victim got married with accused Dipankar Biswas out of their love affairs but subsequently there was demand of dowry and she committed suicide on 14.09.2025. Complainant in her statement recorded u/s.183 of BNSS did not state about any specific demand of dowry but stated about quarrel and not providing pocket expenses by her mother-in-law. It was also stated that she used abusive language. It also appears from the inquest report that at that stage no complaint was made.

Considering the materials in CD prayer for bail is allowed.

Accordingly, prayer for bail is allowed. Petitioners may find bail on furnishing bond of Rs.10000/- with two sureties of Rs.5000/- each to the satisfaction of the Ld. ACJM, Kalna.
