

SC Special Case No. 10 of 2026

Order No. 13 dated 21-04-2026

Ld. Advocate for the accused person is present.

Ld. Spl PP-in-charge is also present with CD.

Today is fixed for hearing of the bail application filed on behalf of the accused Bapi @ Amit Das.

It has been submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused person that in the present case the allegation against the accused person is u/s.6 POCSO Act and this accused is in custody for about 65 days and considering the nature of allegation , period of detention the accused person may be enlarged on bail. He further submits that in the present case investigation is over and therefore there is no necessity of further detention of the accused person. He further submits that no prayer for bail of this accused person is either pending before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court.

Ld. Spl. PP-in-charge opposed the prayer and submits that there is sufficient materials against the accused in the CD and therefore, the prayer must be rejected.

Considered the submissions of both sides.

Perused CD and materials on record.

It appears that victim in her statement recorded before Ld. Magistrate gave a detailed description of the incident. Her medical report shows absence of hymen which gives credence to her statement. The documents in CD suggests that she was about 13 years old.

Considering the serious nature of allegation prayer for bail is rejected.
