

State of Haryana v. Shiva & another

Reply to bail application of accused Shiva filed. Copy given. Heard and perused the records. Keeping in view the entire facts and circumstances, it is amply clear that trial of the case will take a long time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused Shiva in custody. So, the accused Shiva is admitted to bail in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount with usual terms and conditions of the bail that the accused shall not temper with evidence and shall appear in the Court on each and every date except otherwise directed. **Bail bonds and surety bonds furnished. Surety bonds are accepted and attested. Personal bonds are accepted but to be attested by the Jail authorities.** Release warrant of accused Shiva be issued immediately. Accused Shiva be released in this case, if he is not required in any other case.

Intimation regarding documents furnished by surety qua accused Shiva be forwarded to Revenue Authority concerned to make endorsement in its record in compliance to order dated 01.06.2018 passed in CWP No. 4898 of 2018 titled "Hari Chand v. UT Chandigarh & Others" by Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana.

Now the case file be put up on 10.08.2026, the date already fixed for presence of accused.
