The complainant is absent.

Sole accused is present.

An adjournment petition has been filed on behalf of the complainant. Perused the petition. The ground stated therein is not found satisfactory. It further appears from the order sheet that repeated adjournments have been sought on earlier occasions.

The case has been pending since 28.01.2021. The sole accused is present before the Court. Despite lapse of considerable time, no evidence before charge has yet been adduced by the complainant.

The conduct of the complainant in repeatedly seeking adjournments and remaining absent today clearly indicates lack of interest in proceeding with the complaint case. There is no sufficient ground to adjourn the matter any further.

Accordingly, the adjournment petition stands rejected.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the complaint case is dismissed for non-prosecution.
