PO has been transferred. Ld. ACJM, Kalna is in-charge.

Today is fixed for Evidence B/C.

Sole accused namely, **Kartick Sardar @ Sopus** voluntarily surrendered before this court. He is taken into custody and remanded to JC.

Ld. A.P.P. is present.

Accused files a petition and thereby pleads guilty.

Perused the case record and charge-sheet filed against the accused person.

Considered.

It appears therefrom that there are *prima facie* materials to suggest that these accused person has committed an offence punishable u/s 46A(c) Bengal Excise Act.

The sum and substance of accusation for the offence u/s 46A(c) Bengal Excise Act in the form that are read over and explained to the accused person, to which he pleaded guilty by saying "Ami Doshi" and claimed for mercy.

On carefully considered the provision of u/s 46A(c) Bengal Excise Act and the submission of the accused person who prayed the minimum punishment may be imposed upon him.

Considering the nature of the offence, this Court does not find any reason to extend the benefit of the provisions of Sec. 360 of Cr.P.C. On the other hand, considering the nature of offence, no previous conviction of the accused having neither been proved nor pleaded by the prosecution, this Court is of the opinion that the accused persons should be sentenced to undergo Judicial custody till rising of the court and also to pay a fine of Rs.1,500/- for the offence u/s 46A(c) Bengal Excise Act.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

that the accused **Kartick Sardar @ Sopus** is found guilty for commission of offences punishable u/s 46A(c) Bengal Excise Act and as such, the accused person is convicted.

Accused person is sentenced to undergo Judicial custody till rising of the court and to pay fine of Rs 1,500/- for the offence u/s 46A(c) Bengal Excise Act in default, to suffer S.I. for 3 (three) days.

So the accused may be released if fine is paid, if not wanted in any other cases. Judicial Cashier is directed to receive the fine amount as per law, if paid.
