Today stands fixed for hearing of the instant Criminal Misc. Case. C.D. is received.

The record is now taken up for hearing and order.

This is an application u/s 439 Cr. P.C. filed by the petitioner namely **Nabendu Bej @ Chotobabu** in connection with Jhargram P.S. Case No 215/2019 dtd 12.09.2019 u/s 399/402 of I.P.C. & 25/27/35 of Arms Act pertaining to G.R. Case No.888/2019.

It is submitted by the Ld. Defence Counsel that the accused/petitioners are in custody since 20/10/2022. It is also submitted that the C.S. has already been submitted on 23/09/2021 and he along with another person have been shown as absconders in C.S. It is also submitted that all the other accused persons have been enlarged on bail and he also stands on the same footing and prays for his enlargement on bail under any terms and conditions. He further submits that no bail prayer has yet been preferred or rejected by any superior Court, in connection with the said case.

It is submitted by the Ld. P.P. that the C.S. has been submitted and all the other co-accused persons are already on bail.

Perused the L.C.R. & C.D. as well as the other materials on record and on perusal of the same I find that the C.S. has already been submitted and he was brought under arrest on 20/10/2022 on the strength of W/A issued by the Court of Ld.CJM, Jhargram and in my view further detention of the accused person will not serve any purpose to the prosecution and as such I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail of the accused/petitioner.

Hence, the accused/petitioner namely **Nabendu Bej @ Chotobabu** may find bail of Rs. 3000/- with two sureties of Rs. 1500/- each subject to the satisfaction of Ld. CJM, Jhargram with the condition that the petitioner Nabendu Bej @ Chotobabu shall remain present in the court of the Ld. CJM, Jhargram on each and every date and if any violation of the order is there the bail so granted would be cancelled forthwith.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
