As per report of Ahlmad, proclamation issued against accused received back effected and statement of serving official is also recorded today and today the case was fixed for issuance of proclamation against accused but the accused preferred not to turn up in the Court in accordance with the proclamation despite repeated calls of the case and the mandatory period of 30 days stood expired. Accordingly, the accused is declared Proclaimed Offender in terms of section 82(1) Criminal Procedure Code. His properties are ordered to be attached Under section(s) 83 Criminal Procedure Code. Copy of this order be forwarded to the Collector, concerned to attach the properties of the accused in accordance with Punjab Land Revenue Act and to submit report in this regard. Copy of this order be forwarded to Station House Officer Police Station City, Tarn Taran to enable him to initiate proceedings against the accused Under section(s) 174-A of Indian Penal Code. Copy of this order be also forwarded to the Station House Officer Police Station City, Tarn Taran for making an entry in the relevant register of Proclaimed Offenders and the System officer is directed to make necessary additions in the CIS system. The complainant/Prosecution is directed to provide list of properties of the accused/respondent within 7 days from today, upon which, attachment warrants be forwarded to the Collector concerned Under Section 421 Criminal Procedure Code. On request, adjourned to 2.7.2022 for evidence of the prosecution Under section(s) 299 Criminal Procedure Code. SHO Police Station City, Tarn Taran is also directed to forward copy of FIR so registered against the accused to this Court on next date of hearing.
