Today is fixed for appearance.

A petition has been submitted by the accused namely Tapas Ray praying to plead guilty.

The record is taken up for examination keeping in view sec.251 and sec.253 of the Cr.P.C..

The substance of accusation as per the materials of the record is read over and explained to the Ld. Advocate for the accused to effect that the accused has committed the offence punishable u/s 144(1) of Railway Act. Against the same, the Ld. Advocate expresses the plea of guilt on behalf of the accused person.
