

Title Suit No. 604 of 2022 (CIS Registration number-604/22).

Order no.12 dated 28-04-2025

Today is fixed for hearing of the petition filed by the plaintiffs'/decree holders dated 27-03-2025.

The parties file haziras. The defendant raised objection against the instant petition.

Heard both the sides.

By filing this instant petition, the petitioner/plaintiff stated that she has filed this instant suit for eviction against the defendants but she has failed to file the documents before this Court even though she has categorically stated about all the documents in details in her plaint. Hence, the petitioner/plaintiff prayed for leave to file list of documents.

Per contra the defendant raised objection against the instant petition on the ground inter alia that as the plaintiff/petitioner has failed to disclose alleged facts before this Court within time; the instant petition should be rejected at once. Moreover, the plaintiff/petitioner has filed this petition only to drag this suit. Thus, the defendants prayed for rejection of the instant petition with cost.

Considered.

This is a fact that the instant suit has been filed by the plaintiff against the defendants for eviction. This is also a fact that the plaintiff has failed to file the documents before this Court even though she has categorically stated about all the documents in details in her plaint. So, the petition filed by the plaintiff/petitioner on 27-03-2025, is liable to be allowed for ends of justice.

Hence, it is

O-R-D-E-R-E-D

that the petition dated 27-03-2025 filed by the plaintiff/petitioner is hereby considered and allowed on contest but with cost of Rs.400/-.
