The record is taken up for examination of the accused u/s 251 of Cr.P.C.

On the basis of the complaint and the materials so far as collected by the inquiring agency, a prima facie case u/s 46A(c) of B.E Act appears to have been made out against the accused persons. The substance of the accusation is read over and explained to the accused person and on being asked whether they plead guilty or not, they plead guilty by saying " Ami Doshi".

The plea of guilt of the accused person being voluntarily made, is accepted.

It has been submitted that the accused persons comes from a poor background and they are apparently first time offender. Their conduct that they have pleaded guilty voluntarily at this very initial stage may also be appreciated. Hence, they deserve lesser punishment.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the accused persons namely Shankar Das and Kajal Garai found guilty of the offence punishable u/s 46A(c) of B.E Act and they are convicted accordingly. The convicts are hereby sentenced to pay a fine of Rs 1500/-(Rupees Fifteen Hundred only) each for the offence punishable u/s 46A(c) of B.E Act i.d S.I for 10 days .

Cashier of this establishment is directed to take the necessary steps.

Seized alamsats if any be disposed of according to law.
