

C -Case 387/2006

Order dated – 13-01-2021

Record is put up by petition.

Accused Forjun Shekh is brought under arrest. Accused person filed a petition for pleading guilty. Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused.

It appears to me that there is sufficient material against the accused person to proceed against him u/S 3 (a) of the Railway Property (Unlawful Possession) Act.

Accordingly, the accused is examined under section 240 Cr. P.C.

The substance of the accusation to the effect that on 17-04-2006 you were caught red handed by the RPF with the railway materials and you were unable to give valid documents of the same, where by you have committed the offence punishable u/S 3 (a) of the Railway Property (Unlawful Possession) Act is read over and explained to the accused person to which he pleads guilty by saying “Doshi”.

On oral examination he submits that he voluntarily pleading guilty of the offence.

Since he has pleaded guilty voluntarily, the same is duly accepted. So they are found guilty of the offence punishable under section 3 (a) of the Railway Property (Unlawful Possession) Act.

Accordingly, he is taken into custody after canceling the bail Bonds as stood for him.

Hence, it is Ordered,

That the accused person namely Forjun Shaikh is found guilty of the offence punishable u/S 3 (a) of the Railway Property (unlawful Possession) Act accordingly convicted u/S 241 of Code of Criminal Procedure.

Accused Forjun Shaikh is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 1000/- (one thousand) for the offence u/S 3 (a) of the Railway Property (Unlawful Possession) Act in default of payment offline, the accused person would undergo simple imprisonment for a further period of 08 days. The quantum of fine is determined having regard to the nature of offence.

Case against accused Forjun Shaikh is disposed of .

Convict Forjun Shaikh shall be released after payment of the fine amount.
