Today is the date fixed for reconciliation.

Both the parties of the application for dissolution of marriage on mutual consent are present.

Learned Counsels of the parties are also present.

On interaction with the petitioners jointly and individually, it appears that the both are firm on their decision of dissolution of marriage. They inform that they are living separately for more than 1 year, and have settled their dispute amicably including their claims against each other. They further informed that it is impossible for them to live together as husband and wife.

After deliberation with them, it appears that there is no chance of resumption of their conjugal life or reunion. Consequently, reconciliation fails.

The learned counsels of the parties submit for examination for the petitioners. Considering the facts of the case, fixing another date would simply add agony in their lives, and no real purpose would be served. So, on consent of the parties, the case is taken up for hearing.

The petitioners file their separate examination-in-chief supported by an affidavit. They are examined on oath as PWs 1 and 2 respectively. Marriage registration certificate is produced and the same is marked as Exhibit 1. They are not cross examined. PWs 1 and 2 are discharged.

The learned counsels make their submission. Both the learned counsels pray for a decree of dissolution of marriage on mutual consent. The hearing is concluded.
