Today the record is put up at the petition of the Ld. Counsel for the Defense. Both parties are present. Accused Sandeep Kumar Gupta surrenders before this court and is taken into custody.

Ld. Counsel for the accused files and moves a bail petition on behalf of the accused person namely Sandeep Kumar Gupta. Heard the submission of the Ld. Counsel for both sides and considered the same. Accordingly, the petition of the accused person is considered and allowed. Accused Sandeep Kumar Gupta is released on Bail of Rs 2000/- with one surety. I/d to J/C. Recall W/A and/or W/P/A at once, if any.

Given the fact that the accused persons are present in court, plea is conducted u/s. 251 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. On perusal of the record, this court is of the view that there are sufficient grounds to proceed against the accused person u/s. 279/304A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The substance of charge is read over stated and explained to the accused persons in Bengali to which they pleaded not guilty by saying 'aami nirdosh' and claims to be tried.
