Record is put up today by a put up petition filed by the Id. advocate for the accused/ petitioner Nayan Gorain. One bail petition is also submitted on behalf of the accused/ petitioner before this Court.

It is submitted that accused/ petitioner voluntarily surrendered before the Court on 16.03.2022 and it was basically a case of misuse of liberty of bail. So, considering the detention of the accused, prayer for bail may be allowed on any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P opposes prayer for bail by submitting that it is a case of misuse of liberty of bail.

Considered the submissions.

Perused the case record and the seizure list.

It appears that in this case charge sheet has already been submitted. It is simply a case of misuse of liberty of bail. So, considering all these facts prayer for bail filed on behalf of the accused/ petitioner is allowed.

The accused/ petitioner namely Nayan Gorai may find bail of Rs. 5000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2500/- each one of which must be local on condition to meet the O.C of the concerned PS once in a week for one month subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M, Purulia .

Bail petition is thus disposed of.
