Order under Exhibit-I

- 1) Perused the complaint of the complainant and documents presented along with the complaint. The present complaint has been filed by the complainant against the accused under section 138 of negotiable instrument Act for dishonor of cheque.
- 2) After perusing the Complaint, verification and documents produced by the complainant, as well as, the original cheques issued by the opponent and notice given by complainant to opponent regarding the dishonor of cheque and payment of amount due, it prima face appears that Complainant received the cheque from the accused for discharge of debt/liability and opponent has committed the offense under section 138 of negotiable instrument Act. Further, the Bank account of complainant is situated at Deesa only thus, this court has complete jurisdiction for trial of the case.
3. After perusing the whole record at one glance, prima facie, it appears that the there are sufficient ground for proceeding against the Opponent for the trial under Section 138 of negotiable instrument Act. Therefore, I pass the following order:

- Process of summons be issued against the Opponent under section 138 of negotiable instrument Act asking them to remain present before this Court on 14/03/2023 at 11:00 AM.
