EXAMINATION IN CHIEF

I am the IO of this case. On 24.01.2022 I was posted as WSI of police at Dharmanagar Women PS. On that day, the investigation of this case was endorsed to me by the OC, Dharmanagar Women PS Inspr. Smt. Shipra Das. Due to long work with her, I am acquainted with her signature. This is the signature of the endorsing officer on the printed form of FIR marked Ext. P6/PW16 on identification. During investigation, I visited the POs and prepared hand sketch maps. This is the hand-sketch map of the first PO marked Ext.P7/PW16 and this is the index of the same marked Ext.P7(a)/PW16. This is the hand-sketch map of the second PO marked Ext.P8/PW16 and this is the index of the same marked Ext.P8(a)/PW16. I examined the available witnesses and recorded their statements u/s 161 of CrPC. I also got the statement of the informant judicially recorded under section 164(5) of CrPC. On 26.01.2022 at WDN PS complex, I seized from the informant her original birth certificate by preparing a seizure list in the presence of witnesses. This is the said seizure list marked Ext. P9/ PW16. On the same day, at Dharmanagar District Hospital I seized the medical samples of the informant by preparing a seizure list in the presence of witnesses. This is the said seizure list marked Ext. P10/ PW16. On 03.05.2022, at Dharmanagar District Hospital I seized the blood samples of the accused by preparing a seizure list in the presence of witnesses. This is the said seizure list marked Ext. P11/ PW16. I got the informant and the accused medically examined and also forwarded the samples collected to the SFSL and later on also collected report therefrom. I arrested the accused and forwarded him to the Court.

On completion of investigation, finding prima facie case against the accused, I filed charge-sheet against him.

CROSS EXAMINATION

My investigation did not reveal any previous reporting of the matter by the informant to police before filing the instant case in the Court. The complaint petition of the instant case does not mention the name of the scribe and that of the filing Ld. Advocate. The complaint petition also does not bear any signature of the complainant. I have not examined Sri Sajal Rudra Paul and Sri Kajal Chakraborty in connection with this case whose shops have been shown as B and E in the hand-sketch map of the first PO. I have not examined Md. Habib Ali in connection with this case whose house has been shown as D in the hand-sketch map of the second PO.

WV: Md. Habib Ali is the brother of the accused and he would not support the prosecution case against the accused. So, I did not examine him. He is also an FIR named accused in this case.

During investigation, I found the accused absconding and so I prayed before the Court for issuance of warrant against him. As per the birth certificate of the informant cum alleged victim, she was major on the day of the alleged incident.

PW3 Md. Lokman Uddin did not state before me that mother of the accused told him that the informant had been living in her house.

It is not a fact that I tutored the informant to falsely depose against the accused during her examination under section 164(5) of CrPC. It is not a fact that the 161 statements recorded by me in this case were not as per the versions of the witnesses. It is not a fact that I conducted a mechanical investigation and submitted a concocted charge-sheet.
