1. Heard on application for releasing the vehicle i.e. Toyota Etios bearing registration No.CH-01-CB-3987, on sapurdari.

2. Report dated 22.07.2026 from P.S. Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, has been received. As per the report, Car bearing No. CH-01-CB-3987 make Toyota Etios, is lying in the Malkhana of the Police Station and as per registration certificate the owner of the above said vehicle is Balpreet Singh son of Bhagwant Singh, R/o House No.119, Attawa, Sector 42, Chandigarh. The police further reported that they have no objection if the vehicle in question is released on sapurdari to the real owner of the Car.

3. Applicant Balpreet Singh son of Bhagwant Singh had filed the present application in FIR No.173, dated 30.12.2024, registered at P.S. Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, under Section 310 BNS and Section 25 & 27 NDPS Act, for getting the vehicle released i.e. Car bearing No. CH-01-CB-3987 make Toyota Etios, on sapurdari. Applicant had filed the present application on the ground that he is the registered owner of the vehicle in question. Applicant stated that the said vehicle is lying idle in the police station and is no longer required by the police for further investigation. Applicant undertakes neither to change the colour of the said vehicle nor to sell, mortgage, gift or otherwise dispose of the same in any manner without taking prior permission of the Court, till the final disposal of the case. Applicant further stated that he is ready to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by the Court.

4. In view of the report of P.S. Sarabha Nagar, the present application is partly allowed and interim custody of the vehicle in question is ordered to be given to applicant on his furnishing sapurdari bonds in the sum of Rs.5,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount, subject to the conditions that he will not change its colour, condition etc and he will not alienate/dispose off the same in any manner during the pendency of the trial without prior permission of the Court and he will produce the same in the Court on each and every date of hearing failing which sapurdari order will be cancelled. It is made clear that this order

shall be subject to confiscation proceedings, if any, to be initiated on conclusion of trial. Papers be tagged with the connected file.
