O R D E R

1. *Ld. A.P.P present. Accused along with his counsel also present. At this moment, accused through his counsel moved an application for seeking confession for the commission of offence u/s 188 IPC stating therein that he is the first time offender and shall not repeat this act in future and has prayed this Court to take a lenient view in his favour.*
2. *Perusal of the file reveals that the allegations against the accused are that he has committed offence punishable under section 188 IPC. It has been impressed upon the accused that he is not bound to make the confession /admission of the guilt and in case he makes it, he can be convicted in accordance with law, despite this the accused remained obstinate for making the confession and as such his confession statement has been recorded after proper identification, same shall form part of the file. It is made clear that the confession has been made by the accused voluntarily and*

there is no element of coercion, threat, promise, or undue influence in making of it.

3. *Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions made by the accused, a lenient view is taken and accused is hereby convicted for the commission of offence punishable u/s 188 IPC and is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.200/-. The accused has paid the amount of fine in open Court vide G.R. No. A2223617 dated 06/01/2024, same is handed over to the Nazir of this Court who is directed to deposit the same in Govt. Treasury under relevant account head. Needless to mention herein that offence u/s 188 IPC does not affect the moral turpitude and thus conviction u/s 188 IPC shall not affect the character of the accused. The Challan is accordingly disposed off. File be consigned to record after due completion.*
