**ORDER BELOW EXH. 4 IN CR. BAIL
APPLICATION 546/2026
(Rohit Manaji Jadhav Vs. The State)**

Present application is filed under section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (B.N.S.S.) for anticipatory bail to release the applicant. Crime No.412/2026 registered at Pandharpur City Police Station. In addition to this application, present interim application is filed.

02. Learned advocate for the applicant/accused submitted that, the allegations made against the applicant that, he kidnapped the victim. Actually the victim herself came with the applicant. No doubt that the age of the victim is below 18 years but she insisted the applicant to run away. This applicant was ready to perform marriage with the victim. But her family members were about to perform her marriage by force. Therefore, she left the house and the applicant and the victim went to Akulj for some days. Initially she gave statement that, she had no sexual intercourse with the applicant. But after 15-20 days, she alleged that, this applicant had forceful sexual intercourse with her. Police had nothing to recover from this applicant. Hence, the application may be allowed.

03. At present without considering merit of the matter, it is clear that, the victim had changed her statement on two occasion. In that situation, it cannot be said that, the police would get the clothes which were used at the time of incident. Therefore, at this stage his arrest is no more required. He is ready to co-operate with the police during investigation. Therefore, he is entitled to get interim anticipatory bail. Hence, application is entitled to be allowed. Hence, following order is passed :-

ORDER

- 1 The bail application Exh. 4 is allowed.
- 2 In the event of arrest of this applicant in connection with the offence registered at Pandharpur City Police Station vide C.R.No.412/2026 for the offence punishable under Section 64(1),64(2) (i) of B.N.S. and U/s 4,6, 8 and 12 of Prevention of Children From Sexual Offences Act, (POSCO) 2012 , be released on his executing P.R.& S.B. in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with surety in like amount, till decision of this application.
- 3 The applicant shall attend the police station on every Wednesday in between 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m., till decision of this application.
- 4 The applicant shall make himself available to the I.O. as and when required.
- 5 Issue show cause notice to the other side, returnable on 19.08.2026. Both sides are directed to co-operate to decide the matter as early as possible.
- 6 The applicant shall not pressure witnesses and create hurdle in the investigation.
