The Secretary, DLSA, Paschim Bardhaman is requested to engage a trained Mediator, who in turn, be informed to complete the mediation before the next date preferably.

The fees of the mediator be paid by the DLSA authority in terms of Rule 26 of the Mediation Rules, as amended, on settlement of the case through mediation.

The parties are directed to attend the mediation on the date(s) that will be fixed by the mediator at the DLSA office, District Paschim Bardhaman.

If no settlement is reached, neither the parties, the Ld. Advocates, nor the Ld. Mediator will disclose to this Court anything that was discussed at the mediation.

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If a settlement agreeable to the parties is reached, the terms shall be recorded by the Ld. Mediator and signed by the parties and/or their Ld. Advocate on record and be returned to this Court for passing further appropriate orders.
