The record is put up today on the basis of put up petition.

The petition for bail is taken up for consideration.

The Ld. Lawyer for the accused namely Sk. Niyamat Ali while placing the bail application submits that due to communication gap W.A. was issued against accused person on 30.07.2024.

It is further submitted that the accused has voluntarily surrendered and keeping in mind his bona fideness, the Ld. Lawyer prays for bail and recall of the warrant.

Ld. PP-in-charge prays for passing necessary order.

It is found that the accused has misused the liberty of bail which was granted to him earlier.

This court is not oblivious to the fact that the accused has surrendered voluntarily but as to ensure that free and fair trial are conducted expeditiously.

In such facts and circumstances, I am inclined to allow an opportunity to the accused to show his bona fide conduct.

The accused namely Sk. Niyamat Ali may be released on bail by furnishing bond of Rs. 8,000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 4,000/- each subject to satisfaction of Ld. CJM, Bankura i.d. to j/c till date.
