Today is fixed for further evidence.

Accused namely, Sudipto Sardar, is produced from J/C.

Ld. Advocates of both sides are present.

One witness namely, Deblina Sardar (CSW-2) is present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person files a petition praying for bail on the grounds stated therein.

The Ld. P.P.-in-charge vehemently objects the prayer for bail.

Perused the petition. Heard both sides. Considered.

It appears from the bail petition itself that the Ld. Advocate for the accused /petitioner while praying for bail has admitted by stating that a bail petition on behalf of the present accused/petitioner has already been rejected by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta. The same has been submitted by the Ld. P.P. in open Court by filing downloaded copies of orders dated 01.04.2022 in C.R.M. (DB) No. 861 of 2022 and order dated 10.11.2022 in C.R.M. (DB) No. 3922 of 2022 from which it appears that the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta has been pleased to reject the application for bail of the present accused/petitioner.

Under the facts and circumstances and considering the nature and gravity of the alleged offences allegedly committed by the accused person, the bail petition is rejected.

At this stage, the Ld. Advocate for the accused person files a petition praying for time on the grounds stated therein as he has been newly appointed to appear for the accused person.

Objection raised by the Ld. P.P.-in-charge.

Perused the petition. Heard both sides.

Considered the submissions from both sides.

For the ends of justice the prayer for time is allowed. The witness is released without examination.

The accused be remanded to J/C.

To 18.01.2023 for CSW-1 and

19.01.2023 for CSW-2 and 3.

Issue summons accordingly. Prosecution to file written up summons.

The accused person be produced on the date fixed.
