The application u/s **483** of B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the petitioners/accused, namely, 1. Umesh Chowdhury @ Haina @ Shuvo and 2. Radheshyam Mahato @ Sonu in connection with Barjora P.S. Case No. 28/2026 dt. 06.02.2026 u/s 310(4)/310(5)/111/112/61(2) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accused has submitted that no bail petition is pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accused has further submitted that the petitioners/accused are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accused that the petitioners/accused have been in custody since 06.02.2026.

As such, he prays for bail of the present petitioners/accused on any terms and conditions.

Ld. Public Prosecutor raised strong objection.

Perused the record and C.D. Considered.

On careful consideration of the record as well as CD, I find prima facie incriminating materials against both the petitioners/accused. Moreover, the petitioner no. 1 has previous criminal antecedents also. All the accused persons involved in this case are not yet been arrested.

Considering all the aspects, the prayer for bail u/s 483 BNSS stands rejected.
