The application u/s **483** of B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the petitioner/accused, namely, 1.Sri Mantu Bauri and 2.Bidyut Bauri, in connection with Chhatna P.S. Case No. 22/2026 dt.01.03.2026 u/s 85/115(2)/108/3(5)of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

TCR is received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the petitioners/accused, namely, Sri Mantu Bauri and Bidyut Bauri.

Heard the Ld. Public Prosecutor.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accuseds has submitted that no bail petition is pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accused has further submitted that the petitioners/accused are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case.

It is also submitted that the petitioners / accused persons were arrested by the Chhatna Police Personnel on 02.03.2026 and since then, they were in judicial custody.

It is further submitted that petitioners / accuseds are the permanent resident of village-Taljharia, P.S. Chhatna, Dist. Bankura having hearth and home.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accused that the victim was suffering from mental illness.

It is also submitted that there is no previous allegation on demand of dowry. It is also submitted that the marriage was solemnized between the victim and her husband around 20 years back.

As such, he prays for bail of the present petitioners/accused persons.

Ld. Public Prosecutor raised objection and submitted that there are sufficient materials in the CD.

Perused the record and C.D.,

Considered.

Keeping in mind the period of custody and the mental faculty of the deceased, I am inclined to release the petitioners / accused persons on interim bail.

Hence, it is

ordered

that the accused/petitioners are granted interim bail on condition.

Accused/petitioners shall be released on **bail** upon furnishing a bond of Rs.4,000/- each with two registered sureties of Rs.2,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. CJM, Bankura and also on conditions: 1. To meet the I.O as and when called for and 2. Not to tamper or hamper any evidence.

Return the C.D.

The Criminal Misc. Application is thus disposed of.
