The application u/s 483 of B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the petitioner/accused, namely, Billu Sharma @ Villo in connection with G.Ghati P.S. Case No. 16/2026 dt. 24.01.2026 u/s 316(3) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

TCR is received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner/accused namely Billu Sharma @ Villo.

Heard the Ld. Public Prosecutor.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/accused has submitted that no bail petition is pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/accused has submitted that the petitioner/accused is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. It is also submitted that the sections are Magistrate triable in nature. The petitioner/accused is behind the bar since 26.02.2026. During PC interrogation nothing further has been yielded and further PC of the accused/petitioner has not been taken by the I.O. Thus, Ld. Advocate has prays for bail on any terms and condition as this court may deem fit and proper.

Ld. Public Prosecutor vehemently raised objection to the bail prayer and stated that recovery of the article has not yet been completed. The owner of the vehicle has not been arrested or found and under new Act scope of taking into further PC is not yet over.

Perused the record and C.D. Considered.

I have carefully perused the material on record as well as the CD. Accused/petitioner is behind the bar since 26.02.2026 but investigation is not yet over and from the material in CD it can be ascertained that investigation is at crucial stage. Misappropriated TMT Bars are yet to be recovered. It also appears that petitioner/accused did not co-operate with the Investigating Agency during PC period and he might abscond, if enlarged on bail.

Considering all aspects, the prayer for bail u/s 483 of BNSS stands rejected.

Return the C.D.

The Criminal Misc. Application is thus disposed of.
