The application u/s **483** of B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the petitioners/accused, namely, 1. Umesh Chowdhury @ Haina @ Shuvo and 2. Radheshyam Mahato @ Sonu in connection with Barjora P.S. Case No. 28/2026 dt. 06.02.2026 u/s 310(4)/310(5)/111/112/61(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

TCR is received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the petitioners/accused, namely, 1. Umesh Chowdhury @ Haina @ Shuvo and 2. Radheshyam Mahato @ Sonu.

Heard the Ld. Public Prosecutor.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accused has submitted that no bail petition is pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accused has further submitted that the petitioners/accused are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accused that the accused/petitioners are in custody since 06.02.2026. The investigation has been progressed substantially and accordingly he prays for bail of the present petitioners/accused.

Ld. Public Prosecutor raises objection pointing out towards previous criminal antecedent of petitioner no. 1.

Perused the record and C.D. Considered.

On careful perusal of the materials on record as well the CD, it transpires that both the petitioners/accused have been behind the bars since 06.02.2026. There is no substantial recent development in the CD. The search and seizure from the possession of the accused/petitioners had been completed long ago.

Considering that aspect and the period of detention, both the petitioners may be granted bail.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the accused/petitioners are granted **interim bail**.

Both the petitioners/accused shall be released on **interim bail** upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 4,000/- each with two registered sureties of Rs. 2,000/- each, out of which one must be local, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. CJM, Bankura and also on conditions that

- a) the petitioners/accused shall co-operate in the investigation
- b) they shall not abscond and
- c) they shall not involve in any illegal activity during period of bail i.d. to J/C.

Return the C.D.

The Criminal Misc. Application is thus disposed of.
