The application u/s **483** of B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the petitioner/accused, namely, Tara Rani Das in connection with Bankura P.S. Case No. 56/2026 dt. 01.03.2026 u/s 85/108/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

TCR is received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner/accused, namely, Tara Rani Das.

Heard the Ld. Public Prosecutor.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/accused has submitted that no bail petition is pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/accused has further submitted that the petitioner/accused is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/accused that the petitioner/accused has been detaining in custody since 23.03.2026.

It is also submitted that investigation is over and charge sheet has already been submitted.

It is also submitted that other two accused persons are still at large.

As such, he prays for bail of the present petitioner/accused.

Ld. Public Prosecutor raised strong objection and submitted that there is prima facie materials available in C.D.

It is also submitted that this court rejected the bail prayer during the stage of investigation.

Perused the record, C.D., charge sheet and L.C.R.

Considered.

It is found that charge sheet has already been submitted. As such petitioner/accused is not required for the sake of investigation.

It is also found that two accused persons against whom charge sheet has been filed are still at large.

If that be so, there is no immediate prospect of disposal of the case.

Keeping in mind that the petitioner/accused is a female and secondly, petitioner/accused is in custody since 23.03.2026 and lastly, the petitioner/accused is not required for investigation. As such, I am inclined to allow the application for bail as filed by the accused/petitioner.

Hence, it is

ordered

that the accused/petitioner is granted interim bail on condition.

Accused/petitioner shall be released on **bail** upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 4,000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 2,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. CJM, Bankura and also on conditions:

1. shall not tamper the evidence or hamper the witnesses; i.d., to J.C. and
2. shall not threat the defacto complainant or witnesses in any manner whatsoever and

Return the C.D.
