The application u/s **483** of B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the petitioner/accused, namely, Tarekeswar Chowdhury in connection with Bankura P.S. Case No. 174/2026 dt. 24.05.2026 u/s. 126(2)/115(2)/75/351(3)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

TCR is received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the petitioner/accused, namely, Tarekeswar Chowdhury.

Heard the Ld. Public Prosecutor.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/accused has submitted that no bail petition is pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/accused has further submitted that the petitioner/accused is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case.

It is also submitted specifically by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner/accused that the family dispute has been amicably resolved and the de facto complainant is not willing to go with the case.

It is also submitted that the petitioner/accused is in custody since 25.05.2026.

As such, he prays for bail of the present petitioner/accused.

Ld. Public Prosecutor prays for passing necessary order and draws the attention of the court to the statement recorded u/s 183 of BNSS.

Perused the written complaint, LCR and C.D. which contains the statement of the victim recorded u/s 183 of BNSS by Ld. Magistrate.

Considered.

Keeping in mind the period of detention and the material as cropped up during investigation, I am of the view that further detention is not required at all.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the accused/petitioner is granted interim bail on condition.

Accused/petitioner shall be released on **bail** upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 4,000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 2,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. CJM, Bankura and also on conditions:

1. petitioner/accused shall meet the I.O. as and when called for,
2. shall not tamper the evidence or hamper the witnesses; i.d., to J.C. and Return the C.D.

The Criminal Misc. Application is thus disposed of.
